## Hobey Baker

Hobey Baker was the ultimate athlete of his day. Entering Princeton University in 1910, he captained both the hockey and football teams. An amazing player in both sports, Hobey had fantastic reflexes, tremendous skills and was a superior leader, the consummate sportsman who played for the sheer joy of participation. Baker never fouled, he shied away from publicity and refused professional offers. After serving in a flying unit in World War I, Hobey was tragically killed in an air accident shortly after the war. His legend lives on, having been inducted into the College Football Hall of Fame and the Canadian and American Hockey Halls of Fame

## The Award

The Hobey Baker Memorial Award is presented to the top men's collegiate hockey player in the United States. It is college hockey's highest individual honor. It represents much more than excellence on the ice. Award criteria also include strength of character on and off the ice, along with scholastic achievement and sportsmanship. Naturally, the player must contribute to the integrity of his team while displaying outstanding skills in all facets of the game. These qualities epitomize what the Award's namesake is all about.

Each year's winner is decided by establishing a list of 10 finalists as selected by ballot from college hockey coaches and fan votes. Then, a selection committee composed of coaches and supervising officials from each conference, NHL scouts, media, and fan votes make the final determination.
